Advisory Committees

Recreation Commission

The Recreation Commission organizes and implements various recreational programs and other activities for township residents and provides recommendations and oversight of the recreational budget determined by the Township Committee. The Recreation Committee meets the 2nd Monday of the month at 7:30pm in the Municipal Building.

Open Space Advisory Committee (OSAC)

The Open Space Advisory Committee (SAC) provides strategic planning and vision for the implementation of the municipality's "Open Space and Recreation Plan". The OSAC work with third-party consultants and residents for providing recommendations for the Township Committee and to help drive the acquisition, preservation, and enlargement of open space in the Township. The OSAC meets the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7:30pm. in the Municipal Building.

Economic Development Committee (LEDC)

The Lafayette Economic Development Committee (LEDC) is comprised of business owners and residents and is responsible for assessing the opportunities within the municipality to promote and expand businesses and commercial enterprises. The LEDC will drive the development of plans and programs to encourage strengthening existing businesses and attracting new businesses to Lafayette.

Statutory Boards

Land Use Board

The Land Use Board is a combined planning and zoning board and is responsible for reviewing and hearing applications for subdivision, variances, and site plans. The Board is responsible for updating zoning ordinances and the Master Plan of the Township. The Board meets on the 3rd and 4th Thursdays of the month at 7:30pm in the Municipal Building.

Board of Health

The Board is responsible for addressing issues of public health concern with the County Health Department. The Board meets quarterly on the 4th Monday in January, April, July and October at 7:30pm in the Municipal Building.
